A Virtual Tour Through the Animal Kingdom

This virtual online course will review the history of man's relationship with animals from the earliest known recording. We will review various topics including:

- The domestication of wild animals into pets
- The study of various animal species
- How to assess and learn about human impact on wildlife
- The various ways that we can help save and protect animals.



Students will experience new methods of learning by interacting with PBS ACE Instructors and classmates through virtual learning systems. Via video conferencing, we will dive into learning everything about the animal kingdom. We will explore basic care of domesticated pets, review human impact on wildlife, discuss what extinction means, and explore endangered animals from around the globe. In the process, we will look at worldwide efforts to preserve wildlife and to rescue pets that have been maltreated or neglected.
