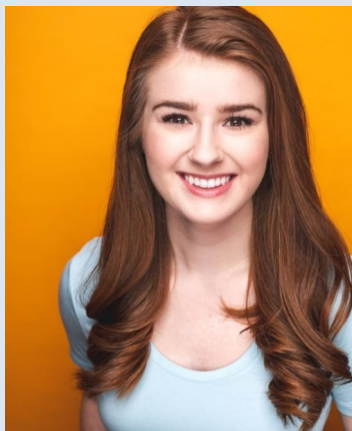
Playwright, Producer, and Performer!
