History of Professional Wrestling

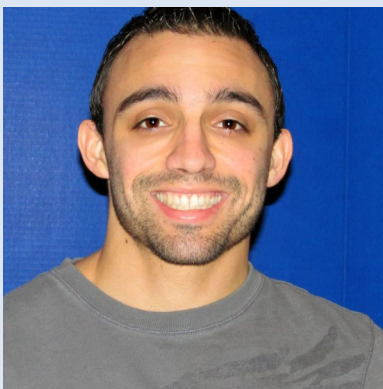
