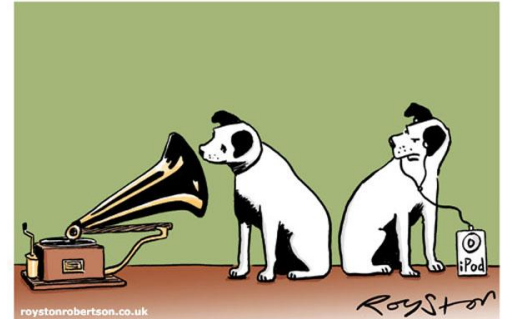

Course Description: Rock and Roll Albums That Rocked the World

In this course, we will explore some of the greatest "LPs" of the rock era. As rock and roll became the dominant musical form in America, the long-playing album replaced single records as the most popular format. We'll look at (and of course listen to), the great records from the 1960s through today, from the days of Pet Sounds and Sgt. Pepper to Led Zeppelin IV and Dark Side of the Moon, to record-breaking albums of the 1970s like Rumours and Frampton Comes Alive. We will include later classics like Nevermind and Jagged Little Pill, all the way to the hit albums of recent years. We will see how our favorite artists turn collections of songs into cohesive works of art. We will appreciate the lost art of the Album Cover and we may even break out our old record players!
